

Post-Offer Veteran Self-Identification

If you served in the military, you are most likely a Protected Veteran. Over time Congress has established four specific categories of veterans who fall under Section 4212 of VEVRAA (the Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act as amended). Veterans who fall under one of these four categories (disabled veteran, 3-year recently separated veteran, active duty wartime or campaign badge veteran or armed forces service medal veteran) are considered Protected Veterans.

Department of Labor guidance from 2015 interprets the Protected Veteran category of <u>Active Duty Wartime or Campaign</u> <u>Badge Veteran</u> to include any veteran who served during a period of war: the Korean conflict (June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955), the Vietnam era for those serving in the Republic of Vietnam (February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975), the Vietnam era for other veterans (August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975), and during the Persian Gulf war (August 2, 1990 – Present).

VEVRAA requires federal government contractors to take affirmative action to employ and advance Protected Veterans in employment. As a government contractor subject to VEVRAA, Leidos is required to submit an annual report to the U.S. Department of Labor noting the number of employees who are in a "Protected Veteran" category.

[] 2 – THREE-YEAR RECENTLY SEPARATED VETERAN ______ (separation date) - any veteran during the three-year period beginning on the date of such veteran's discharge or release from active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval, or air service.

[] 3 – ACTIVE DUTY WARTIME OR CAMPAIGN BADGE VETERAN - a veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval or air service during a war, or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized under the laws administered by the Department of Defense.

[] 5 – ARMED FOCES SERVICE MEDAL VETERAN - a veteran who, while serving on active duty in the U.S. military, ground, naval or air service, participated in a United States military operation for which an Armed Forces service medal was awarded pursuant to Executive Order 12985.
