

GeoRover[®] Mobile Installation Quick Guide

Prerequisites for installation

- A computer installed with Microsoft[®] Windows[®] XP or above.
- Esri[®] ArcGIS[®] v9.3 or above.
- AndroidTM device running Android v2.1.1 or above.
- GeoRover License Manager v2.0.1

Section 1: Installing the GeoRover Mobile Solution

Step 1 – Installing Desktop Software

- 1. Install the GeoRover License Manager and GeoRover Mobile Desktop.
 - a. Physical CD-ROM media is provided upon request of purchase or is available online at <u>www.georover.com</u> for a 30-day trial.
- 2. Run the setup application from the CD-ROM or from the downloaded software to complete the installation.
 - a. Please see the GeoRover License Manager and GeoRover Mobile Desktop User Guides for additional information.

Step 2 – Preparing the Android device

- 1. Begin with the Android device disconnected from the computer.
- 2. From the list of the applications, select the Settings application.
 - a. Select the **Applications** button.
 - i. Enable Unknown Sources.
 - ii. Select the **Development** button.
 - i. Enable USB Debugging.

Step 3 – Installing the GeoRover Mobile Application on the Android device

Online Installation (Recommended)

- 1. If the device has network connectivity, use the Android Browser to navigate to <u>https://www.leidos.com/products/software/georover/GeoRoverMobile.apk</u> (this download will fail if no online connection is available).
- 2. After successful download, select the GeoRover Mobile Application from the notification bar to complete installation. Proceed to Step 8.

Offline Installation

- 3. Be sure the Android device drivers are installed on the computer prior to the GeoRover Mobile installation (see the Android device's user guide for more information about device drivers).
- 4. Directly connect the device to the computer via USB.
- Navigate to Start → All Programs → GeoRover → GeoRover Mobile Device Manager (the GeoRover Mobile Device Manager was included in the GeoRover Mobile Desktop install).
 - a. On the "Install App On Device" tab the device(s) will appear on the Connected Devices list.
 - i. If it does not appear in the Connected Devices list, ensure that the device is connected to a usable USB port on the computer and then click **Refresh**.
 - ii. If the problem persists, the Android device drivers may have not been correctly installed.
 - iii. For help installing the device drivers, refer to the Android device's user guide.
- 6. Select the device from the Connected Devices list, and click **Install GeoRover Mobile**.
- 7. Disconnect the Android mobile device from the computer.

Installation Continued

- 8. On the Android mobile device, browse to GeoRover Mobile in the list of applications.
- 9. The unique "Device Identifier" code will be displayed.
 - a. Copy the unique Device Identifier.
- 10. Connect the Android mobile device to the computer and connect via USB.
 - a. If installing the Trial Version, proceed to Section 2.
 - b. If installing the Full Version, proceed to Section 3.





Section 2: Licensing the Android device (Trial Version)

- 1. Navigate to Start → All Programs → GeoRover Mobile Device Manager and click on the "Trial License" tab.
- Type in the unique Device Identifier from step 6a in Section 1.
 a. Confirm the unique Device Identifier.
- 3. In the "Save To Device" tab, check the correct device in the *Connected Devices* table and click "**Activate Trial**".
 - a. If device is not displayed, please refer to the Android device's user guide.
 - b. If desired, in the "Save To File" tab, browse out to a folder location to save the GeoRover Mobile Application 30-day trial license file.
- 4. A 30-day trial license of the GeoRover Mobile Application will be activated on the connected Android mobile device.
- 5. Disconnect the Android mobile device from the computer to use the GeoRover Mobile Application.

Section 3: Licensing the Android device (Full Licensed Version)

- 1. Navigate to Start \rightarrow All Programs \rightarrow GeoRover Mobile License Manager.
- 2. Click the "Activate License" tab.
- 3. Authorize the GeoRover Mobile Extension and Application by clicking the icon in the "Browse to License File" menu to locate the license received from the GeoRover Product Team.
- 4. Click "Activate".
 - a. Confirm that the GeoRover Mobile Application and Mobile Desktop have been licensed correctly by selecting the "License Status" tab.
- 5. Navigate to Start → All Programs → GeoRover → GeoRover Mobile Device Manager.
- 6. Click the "Activate App" tab.
- Type in the unique Device Identifier from step 6a in Section 1.
 a. Confirm the unique Device Identifier.
- 8. In the "Save To Device" tab, check the correct device in the *Connected Devices* table and click "Activate".
 - a. If the device is not displayed, please refer to the Android device's user guide.
 - b. If desired, in the "Save To File" tab, browse out to a folder location to save the GeoRover Mobile Application license file.
- 9. A full version of the GeoRover Mobile Application will be installed and activated on the connected Android mobile device.
- 10. Disconnect the Android mobile device from the computer to use the GeoRover Mobile Application.
