Gerard A. Fasano currently serves as President of the Defense Group at Leidos. Previously, he served as Chief of Business Development & Strategy where he oversaw efforts to drive business growth, account management, and legislative affairs.

Prior to the merger between Leidos and Lockheed Martin's Information Systems & Global Solutions (IS&GS) in 2016, Fasano served as Vice President, Strategy & Business Development and General Manager for the IS&GS Valley Forge, PA facility, an \$8B business with 26,000 employees. He also had responsibility for merger & acquisition activities within IS&GS and provided strategic direction to the defense & intelligence, civil, commercial markets, and global systems lines of business.

Fasano was also previously Vice President and General Manager for IS&GS. In this capacity, he was responsible for leading a \$3.5B business area with over 10,000 people across more than 200 locations in 42 states and 17 countries. Fasano's career with Lockheed Martin spanned 30 years with a focus on advanced technologies and program execution. During his tenure he has worked assignments with increasing responsibility, providing a wide range of services that include enterprise information technology, data analytics, and operations and maintenance support.
