Explorations in Global Health (ExGloH) is a division of Leidos Health engaged in identifying novel peptide scaffolds to address the Global Health demand for safe and affordable therapies and vaccines for oncology and infectious diseases. By screening diverse libraries and rapidly evolving peptide scaffolds through computational chemistry, ExGLoH identifies linear peptides that bind immunomodulatory molecules. Our peptide-based checkpoint receptor antagonists directly expand vaccine induced antigen-specific T cells and therapeutically rescue immune dysregulation in infectious disease. ExGloH seeks to establish new partnerships for novel discovery and outlicense the use of our peptides for advanced clinical development.
