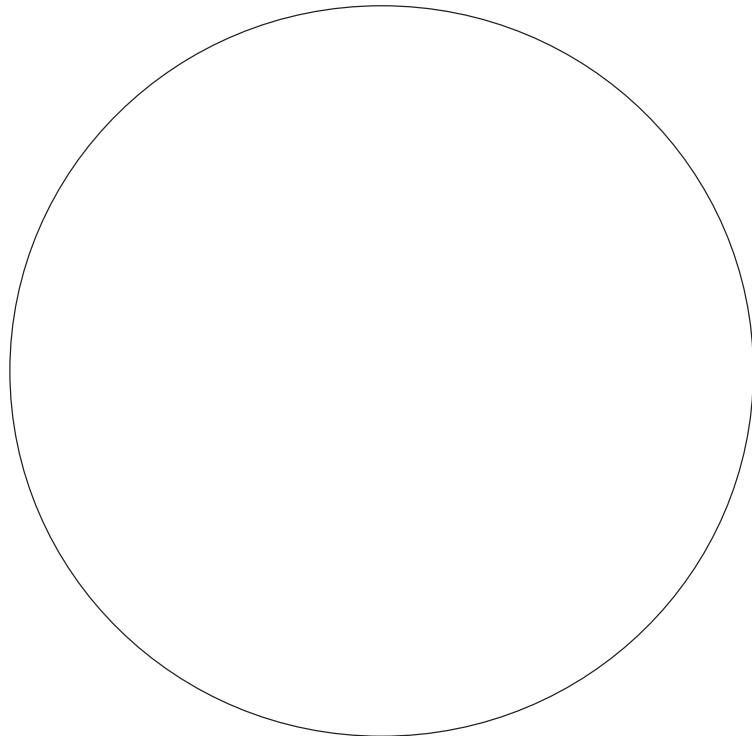
VALUE	WHAT IT MEANS...	WHAT IT MEANS TO YOU...
