A Qualified Helicopter Pilot Instructor, with just under 5000 hours flying experience, he went on to lead the UK Search and Rescue training academy on return from an overseas deployment with US Forces on Enduring Freedom. He ended his service career as the Tri-Service Desk Officer for rotary wing training in late 2006.

Al is a recognised diversity champion - having built very diverse teams and championing leadership development. He has also acted as a mentor for many employees and often advises veterans leaving the services.

In addition, Al is also a Trustee and Director of the Midlands Educational Trust, an Education Academy that runs four primary schools in the Malvern and Worcester area.
