Eddie joined Leidos in September 2016 following a 21-year career as an Officer within the Royal Logistic Corps; before that, she had served in the Territorial Army within the Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, where she also gained a Commission. During her regular military career, she undertook a range of operational tours spanning Bosnia, Iraq and Afghanistan, with several years in Germany. Her time in Iraq included Squadron Command, where she managed all stock inventory and ammunition to support the UK contingent.

Wider appointments included the Permanent Joint Headquarters as a planning officer within the Joint Force Logistic Component. These roles included deployments to support British Embassy staff withdrawal following the Arab Spring uprisings and engagement with wider Government Organisations to plan for major overseas disaster response. She took on the mantle of Chief Instructor at the Defence College of Logistics, delivering training to Defence Logistic Officers at various career stages, and travelling widely overseas to provide training to UK Defence Partners. Her last role within the Military was within the Defence Support Chain Operational Movement's team, where she was responsible for the UK and Rest of the World desk. During this time, she interacted with Leidos following their win of the Logistics Commodities and Services Transformation contract and supported the activity transition.

Eddie initially took on the mantle of bespoke movement project planning, quickly attaining the Head Global Logistics Services role. As Director, her portfolio now spans the Storage and Distribution aspects of the LCST programme. She is the Defence Account Manager for the UK Chapter of the Women's Network and a 2019 Winner of the Civil Division Emerging Leader Business award. Eddie lives in Devon with her family; outside of work, she is actively involved in Scouts and loves the outdoors.
