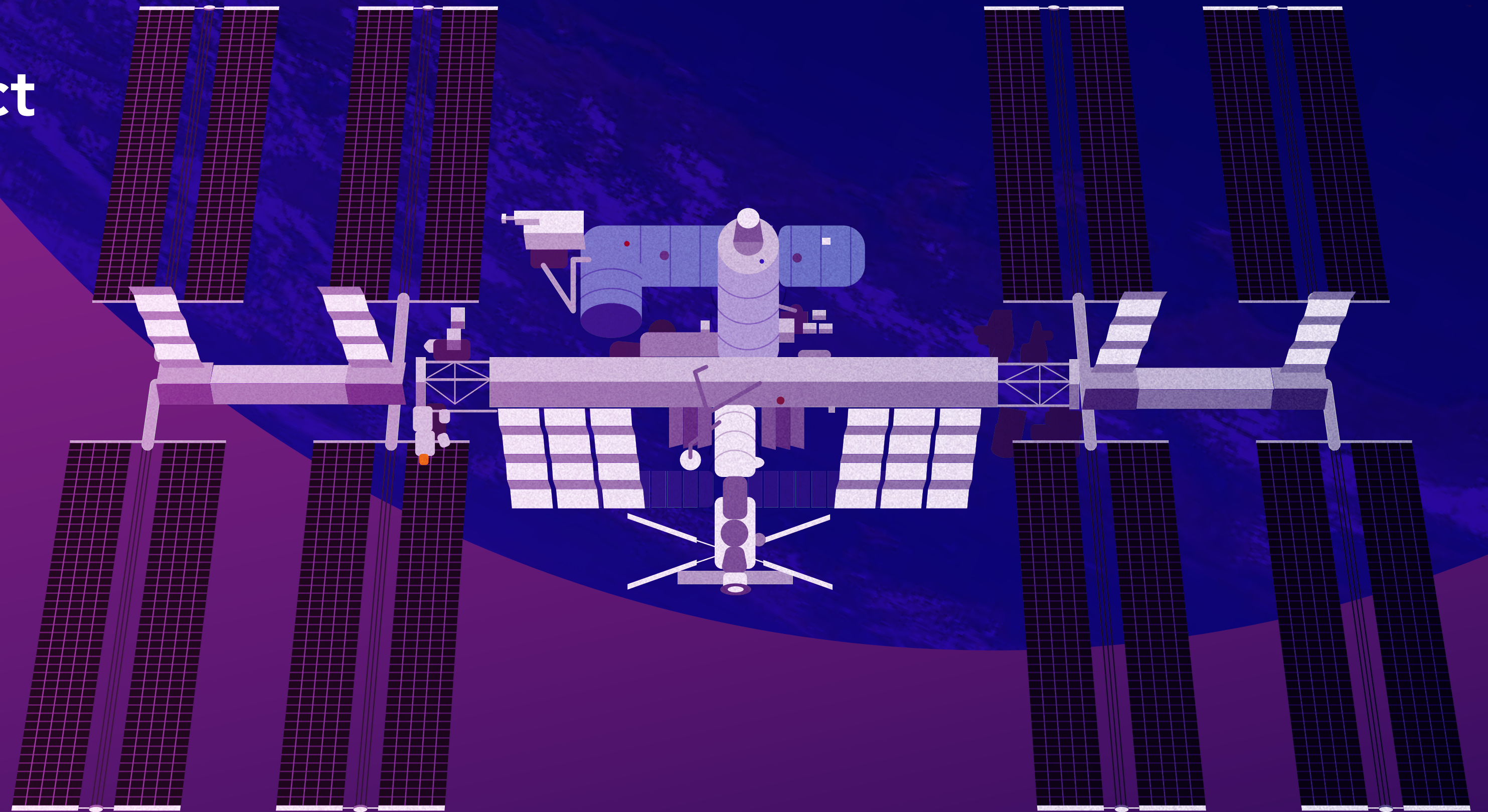


NASA Cargo Mission Contract
