Guy Deshe is the logistics programme lead for Leidos Israel. Guy joined Leidos in May 2018 after three years with Mashik - Research and Method for Business Improvement, where he was the Managing Director for the supply chain business unit. In this role, he had full P&L responsibility, leading and implementing a diverse portfolio of projects and organizational changes in different industry verticals including defense, retail, health, hi-tech, banking, energy and utilities.
