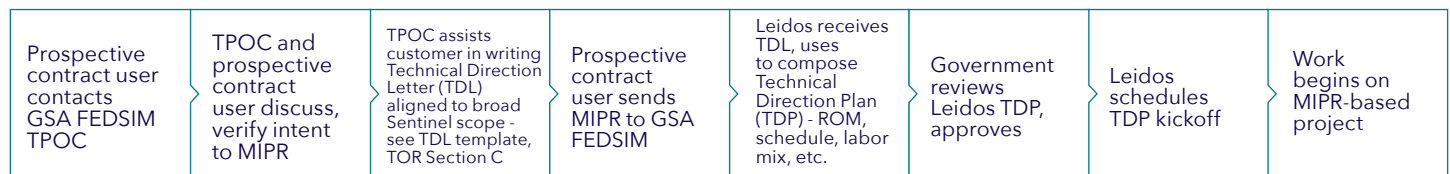

TYPE/STRUCTURE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> › Single award task order under OASIS IDIQ – Leidos awarded as prime › Multi-tenant – designed to be used by any DoD or non-DoD customer with a C5ISR contract need for R&D, technology insertion, engineering, test & evaluation, or fielding and operations support, to include PED, cybersecurity and training
FEE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> › CPAF labor; CPFF on ODCs; M&E › 0.1% CAF fee › FEDSIM/GSA fee for assisted acquisition services
FUNDING TYPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> › Can ingest any type of funding including FMS › Funding placed on contract through Technical Direction Letters tied to MIPRs
CLASSIFICATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> › Work can be performed at any classification level › Ability to “firewall” at project level if needed

CONTRACT ACTION TYPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> › Sentinel task order already competed under OASIS IDIQ, awarded to Leidos, the single prime awardee for the task order › All funds placed on Sentinel count as competed contract actions

VALUE PROPOSITION FOR PUTTING WORK ON SENTINEL CONTRACT

- › **BROAD SCOPE** – C5ISR solutions across all TRLs from R&D to O&M, including technology insertion, engineering, fielding support, PED/intelligence analysis, cybersecurity, and training.
- › **QUICK & EASY TO USE** – The average timeframe from TDL issuance to project kickoff is < 30 days. Putting funds on contract involves sending MIPR and Technical Direction letter only (the contract is already competed and does not require a sole source justification).
- › **PROJECT LEVEL CONTROLS & EFFICIENCY** – The TDL states the project requirements and specifications. After project kickoff, the funding customer supports performance monitoring and GSA/FEDSIM handles the day-to-day administration.
