ENHANCING C5ISR MISSIONS AT GLOBAL SCALE

Sentinel is a \$1.51B task order to accelerate command, control, computers, communications, cyber, intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (C5ISR) innovation across all technology readiness levels, stood up by the Office of the Secretary of Defense (OSD) and sponsored by the National Security Innovation Network (NSIN). As the single prime awardee for the task order, Leidos enables rapid insertion of technologies across the mission spectrum to support warfighters in maintaining a technical high ground and decision advantage.

The Sentinel task order is multi-tenant, designed to be used by DoD or non-DoD customers for a range of C5ISR needs. The value proposition for putting work on this contract is threefold:

Broad scope

C5ISR solutions across all technology readiness levels (TRLs) from R&D to O&M, including technology insertion, engineering, fielding support, PED/intelligence analysis, cybersecurity, and training.

Quick & easy to use

The average timeframe from TDL issuance to project kickoff is < 30 days. Putting funds on contract involves sending MIPR and Technical Direction letter only (the contract is already competed and does not require a sole source justification).

Project level controls & efficiency

The Technical Direction Letter states the project requirements and specifications. After project kickoff, the funding customer supports performance monitoring and GSA/FEDSIM handles the day-to-day administration.
