Angus Mathie is the Associate Director, Business Development for the Logistics and Mission Support Division.

Having been a boy soldier in the Territorial Army's London Scottish Regiment, Angus Mathie entered Sandhurst straight from school in 1979. Commissioned at 19 into the Royal Corps of Transport (later the Royal Logistic Corps) he completed a full 37 year career, retiring in 2015. Starting at South Cerney in 1980 as an Air Transport Liaison Officer, highlights of his military career include providing covert transport support in Northern Ireland and operational attachments to the Infantry, Royal Armoured Corps and US Central Command.

Other operational service included 5 tours in Northern Ireland and tours of Bosnia, the Solomon Islands, East Timor, Iraq and Afghanistan, the last as the Commander of Camp Bastion 2009-2010. Staff appointments included three years in Sydney on exchange to the Australian Army's Land HQ and in MOD Security Policy and Operations with ACDS (Log Ops). His final post was Commander Bicester Garrison and Operations Director for DE&S Logistic Services until early 2015.

Retirement lasted 3 weeks before taking up the post of Senior Customer Relations Manager with Team Leidos, helping in the transformation of the MOD's strategic base logistics. He now works as the Business Development lead for the Logistics and Mission Support Division and lives near Marlborough, Wiltshire.
